Deutsche Bahn at a glance

(Berlin, March 23, 2017) Deutsche Bahn AG was founded in 1994. Today it is among the world's leading mobility and logistics companies, operating more than 2,000 locations in over 130 countries. More than 300,000 employees, including just under 196,000 in Germany, set out each day to ensure mobility and logistics services for our customers and efficiently manage and operate the rail, road, air and ocean transport networks necessary to do so. In the 2016 fiscal year, adjusted revenues were roughly EUR 40.6 billion and adjusted EBIT was approximately EUR 1.9 billion.

Deutsche Bahn's core business is rail operations in Germany, with over two billion passengers and roughly 205 million metric tons of freight transported by rail each year. Over 633 million customers in Germany use DB Group buses every year. For DB, the key to long-term success is satisfied customers, outstanding quality, skilled and highly motivated employees, and environmentally friendly products.

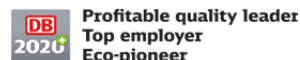
